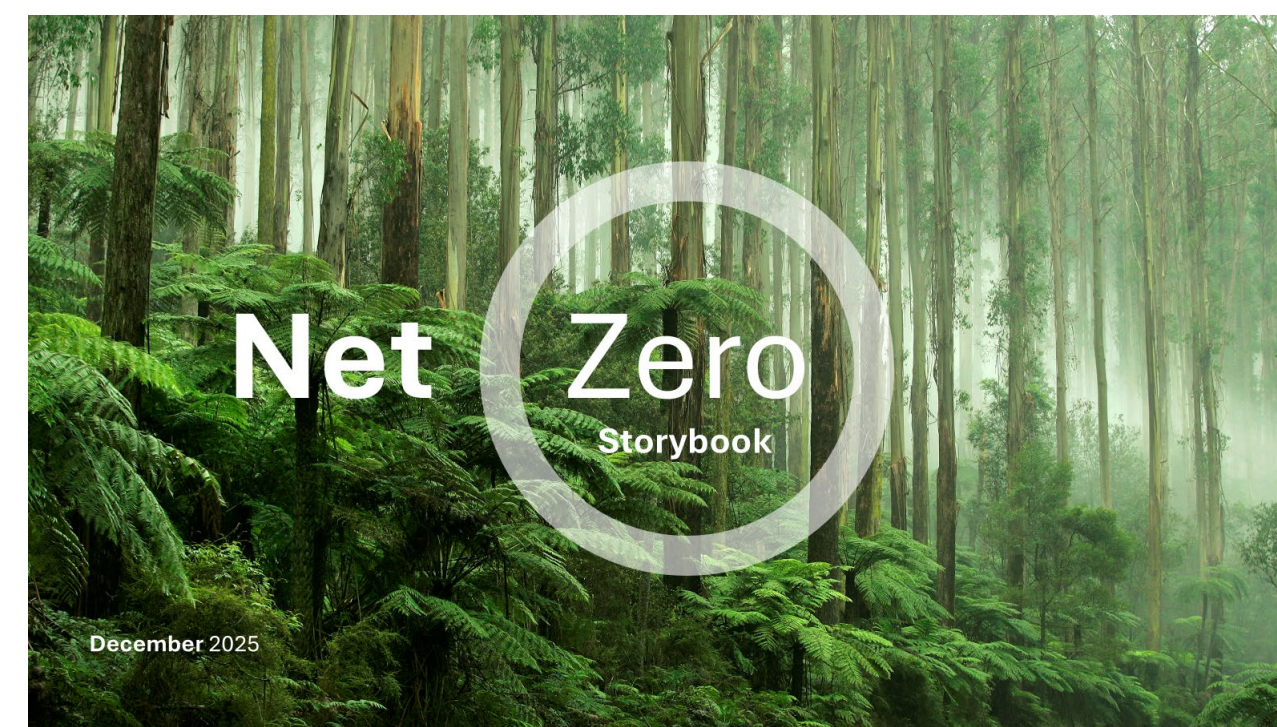

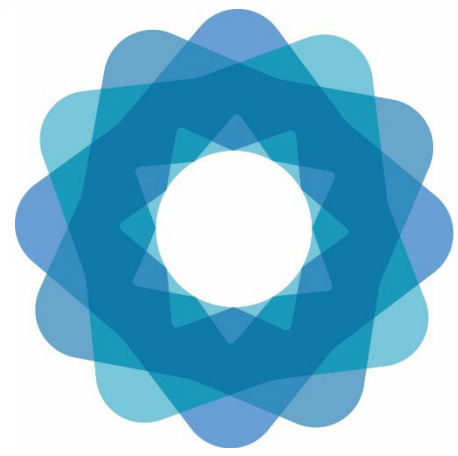


Activities for 2026/27
