State of Environmental Statistics at Statistics Sierra Leone (SSL)

- 1. Environmental Statistics was a section in the Division of Demographic and Social Statistics;
- 2. The idea was to create a data base comprising of indicators about environmental issues such as air pollution and degradation affecting the welfare of people resident in Sierra Leone;
- 3. Lack of capacity and equipments to measure environmental pollution and the level of degradation in communities.

Transition of Environmental Statistics

- 1. Due to efforts to integrate environmental statistics and national accounts, environmental statistics is now temporarily transferred to the Economic Statistics Division;
- 2. In our plan to implement SNA 2008, environmental statistics will be a corollary to all national accounts activities;
- 3. Currently, the national accounts statistics section is working with a consultant to establish a Mining Sector Account under the IMF Tropical Trust Fund (TTF) on the Management of Natural Resource Wealth (MNRW).

Mining and quarrying sector Accounts

- 1. currently, we are actively involved in the survey of quarrying activities covering sand extraction and stone breaking along the peninsula of Western Rural Area;
- 2. Estimates of sand extraction and stone breaking are used to feed compilation of the sub sector in the GDP;
- 3. The Mining Sector Account will used data provided by MMMR, BSL, GGDO, NMA and a planned survey on artisanal mining activities in the country.

The Mining Sector Account will be based on the SUT format

- 1. The Agricultural subsector of Forestry which has the following components: logging of timbers, fuel wood consumption, charcoal consumption etc;
- 2. The utilities subsector of water, electricity and air conditioning production and consumption aggregates;
- 3. We are also planning to collect data from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Ministry of Land and the Environment

Challenges/Recommendations

- 1. Support of activities to develop Environmental statistics by government and other donors;
- 2. Capacity building in the implementation of SEEA Central Framework 2012;
- 3. Coordinating with other stakeholders at home and abroad with a view to develop an Environmental Statistics Section/Division;
- 4. Other Technical and financial issues for conducting small surveys and collecting administrative data.
