#### How to send the information to Eurostat

The standard tool for the transmission of statistical data to Eurostat is the eDAMIS system. The system creates a secure environment for the transmission of data, it offers a logging of all transmissions and it sends confirmations of delivery. The eDAMIS system has been installed in the National Statistical Institutes and your local eDAMIS coordinator will give you a user-id and password.

When you enter eDAMIS for the first time you will get a form to specify what data sets you will send. It asks for your country and your institution. Click the option button that you want to send data to Eurostat. In the next screen you have to select your domain and data sets you will provide data for; the domain is **ENVPFLAC**. You can send data by selecting 'transmission' in the toolbar (top left) and next 'send datafile'. Select the data file from your system with 'browse' and eventually correct further attributes. The xml files generated by the data entry tool comply with the Eurostat naming conventions, so the system should already correctly recognise the file attributes. If you want to send more than one data file at once, you click 'Add datafile' (bottom right). When you are done, you click 'Perform transfers' (bottom right).

[1] In general, Air Emissions Accounts data should include CO<sub>2</sub> emissions from biomass used as fuel. Usually, CO<sub>2</sub> emissions from biomass are excluded from the UNFCCC totals (though reported separately). It has been decided to include two data sheets for CO<sub>2</sub> emissions: one without emissions from biomass and one explicitly showing those from biomass. By requesting data in this way it is clear exactly if CO<sub>2</sub> emissions are included or not in the Air Emissions Accounts data

#### EXPLANATORY AND TECHNICAL NOTES

### 1 Explanatory notes on main Air Emissions Accounts principles in relation to ESA 95

#### 1.1 Economically-oriented emission accounts:

- 1.1.1 The European System of National and Regional Accounts (ESA 95)<sup>[1]</sup> is an internationally compatible accounting framework for a systematic and detailed description of a total economy, its components and its relations with other total economies. It sets out statistical principles and rules on how to compile economic data<sup>[2]</sup>.
- 1.1.2 Environmental accounts constitute satellite accounts to the ESA 95 for the analysis of the interaction between the environment and the economy (ESA 95, paragraph 1.18.). An important feature of a satellite accounts such as air emission accounts is that in principle all basic concepts and classifications of the standard ESA 95 framework are retained (ESA 95, paragraph 1.20.).
- 1.1.3 In Air Emissions Accounts, emissions are to be attributed to economic activity entities – i.e. sub-entities of the total economy – similarly as economic data (e.g. gross value added, output) are attributed in economic accounts transmitted to Eurostat.
- 1.1.4 This requires a clear definition of statistical units and their groupings (ESA 95, paragraphs 2.01. ff.). The ESA 95 system uses three types of units, corresponding to two very different ways of subdividing the total economy (ESA 95, paragraph 2.03.):
- (1) **institutional units**<sup>[4]</sup> (which can be further grouped to institutional sectors<sup>[5]</sup>) appropriate for the analysis of economic behaviour; and the following two types appropriate for the analysis of technico-economic relationships:
  - (2) **local kind-of-activity units**<sup>[6]</sup> (which can be further grouped to **industries**), and
  - (3) **units of homogeneous production**<sup>[7]</sup> (which are further grouped to **homogeneous branches**).
- For Air Emissions Accounts the technico-economic types of unit (2 + 3) are most suitable as far as emissions related to production processes are concerned.

- 1.1.5 Local KAUs and industries: The ESA 95 divides institutional units **into local kind-of-activity units (local KAUs)** on the basis of their type of activity<sup>[8]</sup>. Institutional units which are producers may carry out more than one activity – a **principal activity** and one or more **secondary activities**. Hence, institutional units involved in production have to be partitioned with regard to the type of activity into local KAUs. They form the smallest entity. A local KAU groups all the parts of an institutional unit in its capacity as producer which contributes to the performance of a particular activity at the class level (four digits) of the **NACE rev.2. In principle, as many local KAUs must be registered as there are secondary activities and the secondary activities should be classified under different headings from the principal activity.** However, if adequate information is not available, a local KAU may include one or several secondary activities.

The group of all **local KAUs** engaged on the same, or similar, kind-of-activity constitutes an **industry**. The classification used for grouping local KAUs into industries is the NACE rev. 2.<sup>[9]</sup>

- 1.1.6 Units of homogeneous production and homogeneous branches: For more refined analysis of the production process, use is made of an **analytical unit** of production (i.e. artificial or fictive). This unit – which is not observable (except in the case of a local KAU only producing one type of product) – is the **unit of homogeneous production**, defined as covering no secondary activities. If a goods and services producing institutional unit carries out a principal activity and also one or more secondary activities, it will be partitioned into the same number of units of homogeneous production. Ancillary activities are not separated from the principal or secondary activities.
- Units of homogeneous production are grouped to **homogeneous branches**. Homogeneous branches are units designed for economic analysis. Units of homogeneous production cannot usually be observed directly; data collected from the units used in statistical enquiries have to be rearranged to form homogeneous branches. The classification of homogeneous branches used in the input-output tables is based on the Classification of Products by Activity (CPA). The CPA is a product classification whose elements are structured according to the industrial origin criterion, industrial origin being defined by **NACE rev.2**.
- 1.1.7 Please indicate (in the sheet 'questions') which type of unit has been applied for your Air Emissions Accounts (either **local KAUs** grouped to **industries** or **units of homogenous production** grouped to **homogenous branches**) and in how far they are compatible to economic data (e.g. gross value added) transmitted to Eurostat.
- Please note, that the usual approach for economic data transmitted to Eurostat is a breakdown by local KAUs grouped to industries. In the ideal case, local KAUs are defined in an almost "pure" way, i.e. all secondary activities are separated. In this ideal case, **local KAUs** should be almost the same as **units of homogeneous production**.

#### 1.2 Resident principle:

- 1.2.1 Air Emissions Accounts follow the principles and definitions defined by ESA 95. According to ESA 95, the total economy is defined in terms of **resident units**. A unit is said to be a resident unit of a country when it has a centre of economic interest on the economic territory of that country – that is, when it engages for an extended period (defined usually as one year or more) in economic activities on this territory. Air Emissions Accounts refer only to activities of residents' economic units.
- 1.2.2 Since the Air Emissions Accounts encompass only emissions that can be traced to economic activities, emissions from non-economic agents (e.g. nature) are not to be included. Furthermore, nature's absorption of substances is not taken into account in Air Emissions Accounts. For instance, sequestration of carbon in biomass should not be deducted from CO<sub>2</sub> emissions in Air Emissions Accounts.
- 1.2.3 Emissions accounted for in Air Emissions Accounts must be those stemming from national economic activities (i.e. those generated by resident units) rather than from sources on the national territory. Emissions by resident units abroad, essentially covering tourists driving abroad and enterprises engaged in international transport activities, should be fully included in the accounts either under the economic activity earning the value added from these activities or under households (transport). Conversely, all emissions by non-resident entities within the national boundary (foreign lorries and tourists) should be excluded.

The ESA framework consists of two main sets of tables:

(a) the sector accounts (ESA 95, chapter 8): provide, by institutional sector, a systematic description of the different stages of the economic process: production, generation of income, distribution of income, redistribution of income, use of income and financial and non-financial accumulation.

(b) the input-output framework (ESA 95, chapter 9) and the accounts by industry (ESA 95, chapter 8): describe in more detail the production process (cost structure, income generated and employment) and the flows of goods and services (output, imports, exports, final consumption, intermediate consumption and capital formation by product group).

The ESA encompasses concepts of population and employment (ESA 95, chapter 11). These concepts are relevant for both the sector accounts and the input-output framework.

In general, all white cells in the data sheets can be filled with numbers. The yellow-shaded cells are reserved for footnotes.

- air emissions by industry (former standard table 1b)
- household air emissions (former standard table 2b)
- bridging items (former standard table 3)

#### 2.4 Classification of economic activities (industries) and specific notes related to single NACE divisions

*Classifications:*

The proposed industry classification is NACE 2-digit<sup>[10]</sup>. The data sheets should be filled by countries **using this 2-digit (A64) classification level of industry breakdown with priority**.

If it is not possible to fill in all the details of the 2-digit classification level, additional **interim aggregates** of economic activities should be used. The data sheets offer two levels of interim-aggregation in accordance with the **NACE rev.2** hierarchy: **A38** and **A21** (1-letter).

The data sheets contain a nested listing of the three official levels (**A64**, **A38**, **A21**).

Please report emission data for the most disaggregated level for which data are available; Eurostat will aggregate later. If an aggregate should differ from the sum of its parts, fill in the respective aggregate and add a footnote explaining the difference.

The allocation of FISIM (Financial Intermediation Services Indirectly Measured) in the national accounts has been revised by November 2005. According to the new rules the use of FISIM must be allocated to industries which consume the service.
