# Background

- SEEA approved by UNSC as worldwide statistical standard  
=> Implementation
- OECD Green Growth  
=> Further improvement of the statistical underpinning

# OECD Green Growth Strategy

Four groups of indicators:

- Environmental and resource productivity of the economy
- Natural asset base
- Environmental dimension of quality of life
- Economic opportunities and policy responses

Set of 25 indicators

=> identification of headline indications



# Collection of SEEA Core Tables

- Proposal to CSTAT (end of 2011)
- Top 10 of high priorities
- Included in the STD Program of Work, approved by CSTAT (4-5 June)
- Top 10 (nr. 6) of high priority outputs
- Following step: OECD Budget Process

# Collection of SEEA Core Tables

- Selection of tables, based on:
  - Policy relevance / OECD Green Growth Strategy
  - Availability of data: nationally and at the OECD
  - Alignment with initiatives at the EU-level
  - Priorities in the area of national accounts (e.g. measurement of wealth)
- Obvious candidates: emissions and natural assets
- Collection starting in 2013
