




1. Ecosystems in Guatemala

National classification of ecosystems

- Interest on a national perspective
- Based on live zones (sensu Holdridge)
- It offers a suitable platform for scaling-up





1.- Green Climate Fund Project

Project: Building livelihoods resilience to climate change in the upper basins of Guatemala

Accredited Entity: UICN -Guatemala Starting on January 2020

GCF: USD 22M

Korean Government: USD 10M

Guatemalan Government: USD 11M

Main focus: Ecosystem based adaptation

- Deforested areas
- Services that can be provided




Figure 1: Climate change scenarios in Guatemalan Highlands by life zones (sensu Holdridge). Base = year 2000, projection to 2020 and 2050.





2.- Forest and Environmental Fiscal Policy

- Forest and Ecosystem Accounts are a suitable way to explain the importance of forest at the national level
 - Forest National Institute is lobbying to increase Budget
- Environmental Fiscal Policy
 - Ministry of Finance is preparing fiscal policy based on NCA
- Policy analysis:
 - Identification of forest restoration areas, depending upon provision of ecosystem services







3.- Climate change in Guatemala

- Impact on agriculture production




Base line: Year 2015 Scenario A2: Year 2050
