







Mandate




- Area A focuses are:

Current activities




- 2 key activities for area A:

Landscape Assessment



- The goal of the landscape was to create an internal resource that would help UNCEEA members identify emerging policy issues and important topics, including relevant initiatives and groups.
- The assessment was initiated under the leadership of Statistics Canada and was 'finalised' at the end of 2023.
- The assessment consists of:
 - A table providing detailed information on relevant groups.
 - A mapping that provides a visual overview of the space in which the UNCEEA operates.
- The landscape is not meant to be comprehensive. It represents the areas where we have familiarity.
- It is expected that the landscape will be updated annually by Area A members.



- The interlinkages in the landscape assessment also highlight the complexities in using SEEA and related statistics.



'Uses of the SEEA for Policy' webinar series.



- A new webinar series has been launched in 2024.
- The webinar series aims to highlight various priority and emerging policy areas that can be informed by the SEEA.
- The goals of the webinar series are to:
 - Showcase the benefits of the SEEA
 - Demonstrate how the SEEA can address policy questions
 - Explore areas where the SEEA could potentially play a role in informing policy and decision-making.
- The webinars also provide an opportunity to bring together different disciplines.



Webinar 1: Monitoring and Informing the GBF



- The 1st SEEA webinar was held on Monday 15 April.
- The webinar outlined how SEEA provides the methodological basis for several indicators of the monitoring framework of the Global Biodiversity Framework (GBF).
- The programme included presentations from the CBD secretariat, an overview of the key indicators and a panel discussion with selected countries (Mexico, Canada, and Australia).
- This webinar was aimed to provide a bridge to other communities, particularly CBD focal points.



Webinar 2: Implementation of the SEEA ecosystem accounting




- The 2nd SEEA webinar was held on Monday 20 May.
- The webinar outlined country experiences in implementing SEEA ecosystem accounts, which underpin key headline indicators from the Global Biodiversity Framework.
- The webinar was hosted by the chair of Area B2 and included country presentations from South Africa, India, Ireland and the United Kingdom.









Summary of webinars.



- The webinars were well attended with approximately 200 participants in each webinar.
- Both webinars have been recorded and are freely available online. The two recordings have garnered more than 600 combined views.
- Future webinars are in the early stages of planning over the coming year, with sustainable finance and business accounting identified as possible topics.



Future activities




- Continuing the 'Uses of the SEEA for Policy'.
