# **Update of the SEEA Central Framework: Background**

- At its 18<sup>th</sup> Meeting in 2023, the UNCEEA "agreed to an update of the SEEA CF with a focused scope while requesting the SEEA CF TC to further elaborate the criteria for prioritization of the issues, further evaluate the costs and benefits of addressing the issues and develop a timeline for addressing each issue
- 2023-2024: SEEA CF TC worked on refinement of issue list and project management framework for the update
- March 2024: UNSC endorsed the proposal to update the SEEA CF



### Issue list for SEEA CF update

#### **Review list of issues**

- Input by SEEA CF TC, London group, UNCEEA Bureau, UNCEEA, various experts
- List now contains 35 issues

#### **Grouping of the issues**

- a) Overarching topics, including consistency with SNA
- b) Physical flow accounts
- c) Environmental activity accounts and related flows
- d) Asset accounts

#### **Prioritization**

- Based on policy impact and benefit; conceptual impact; complexity; and time requirements → priority 1 to 4
- Additional: issues identified as "must-do's"



#### Global consultation for issue list

- Revised following UNCEEA review in April
- The list of issues and prioritization can undergo a global consultation during 2024 Q3 after the 19th UNCEEA meeting
- The global consultation will last for 6-8 weeks
- Global consultation aimed at broad audience —SEEA community, national accountants, environmental economists, academia, private sector, etc.
- The **SEEA CF TC** will summarize the results of the global consultation and revise the list of issues based on the feedback
- To be sent to UNCEEA Bureau and the broader UNCEEA for approval
- The list of issues will then be presented to the UNSC at its 56<sup>th</sup> Session.



### **Project management framework**

- Project management framework has been further refined and clarified; underwent consultation with UNCEEA in April
- Three-pronged approach:
  - (a) undertaking technical research and reaching recommended guidance on a set of specific issues;
  - (b) engaging in progressive rounds of inclusive, global consultations and review
  - (c) coordination and collaboration with different stakeholders.
- Plan to include a broad set of users in the update process, including statisticians, national accountants, policy makers, academia, environmental economics community, private sector, etc.
- Important to coordinate between other revisions of relevant standards/classifications

### **Project management framework**

- Overall governance
  - SEEA CF TC, with UNSD as Secretariat, will lead the management of the SEEA CF update process
  - Task teams will be established under the TC CF to address the issues and prepare guidance notes
  - Editorial Board will be established to oversee drafting, and includes the SEEA CF TC and co-publishing agencies
  - Bureau of the UNCEEA, including all copublishing agencies, will provide regular oversight and coordination
  - Committee to provide oversight at a high level
- Project management framework will also be sent to the UN Statistical Commission in 2025

# Coordination with revisions of other standards/classifications

- 2025 SNA:
  - SEEA CF TC and UNCEEA have/are contributing to global consultations
  - Chair and Secretariat of TC participate in OECD informal Expert Group on Natural Capital; provide regular updates to TC
  - UNCEEA will be given opportunity to review the handbook in November (handbook to be published early 2025)
- TC contributed to final review of Classification of Environmental Purposes (CEP), which was endorsed by the UN Statistical Commission in 2024



# Coordination with revisions of other standards/classifications

- COFOG
  - Chair and Secretariat of TC participating in TT on COFOG revision
  - Providing issues from a SEEA perspective for list of issues, which will undergo global consultation in Q3 2024
- GFS
  - TC plans to coordinate with the update of GFS
  - One of themes of GFS update is "natural resources and environment"
- Intention to collaborate on issues relevant to updates of SEEA CF, COFOG and GFS



# Statistical Guideline on Measuring Flows of Plastics Along the Life Cycle

- Drafted by UN Environment Programme
- Intended to provide NSOs with guidelines on compiling statistics on plastics, including a PSUT for plastics and plastic waste consistent with SEEA
- TC reviewed the guidelines, focusing on consistency with the SEEA CF
- UNEP to conduct a global consultation later this summer
