- SEEA has been identified as an integrated framework that may be used for the economic and environment pillars of the SDGs
- Philippines - 7 milestones related to SEEA since 1991 done by various agencies with development partners
- UNSD's initiative >> Environmental-economic accounting for evidence-based policy in Africa and Asia including the Philippines in partnership with PSA
- The project in the Philippines will:
 - strengthen institutional arrangements including data sharing
 - building capacity to compile selected accounts on a regular basis
 - promote effective communication and use of the accounts

- roadmap

 - national monitoring and voluntary national reviews of SDGs
 - monitoring framework for the post-2020 Global Biodiversity Framework
 - continued institutional engagements
 - communication and advocacy (public engagement, knowledge tools and methods)
 - Capacity building (retooling)
- land account as a first initiative
- identification of policy priorities, country interests, relevant stakeholders and capabilities for the SEEA implementation

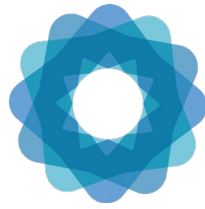
