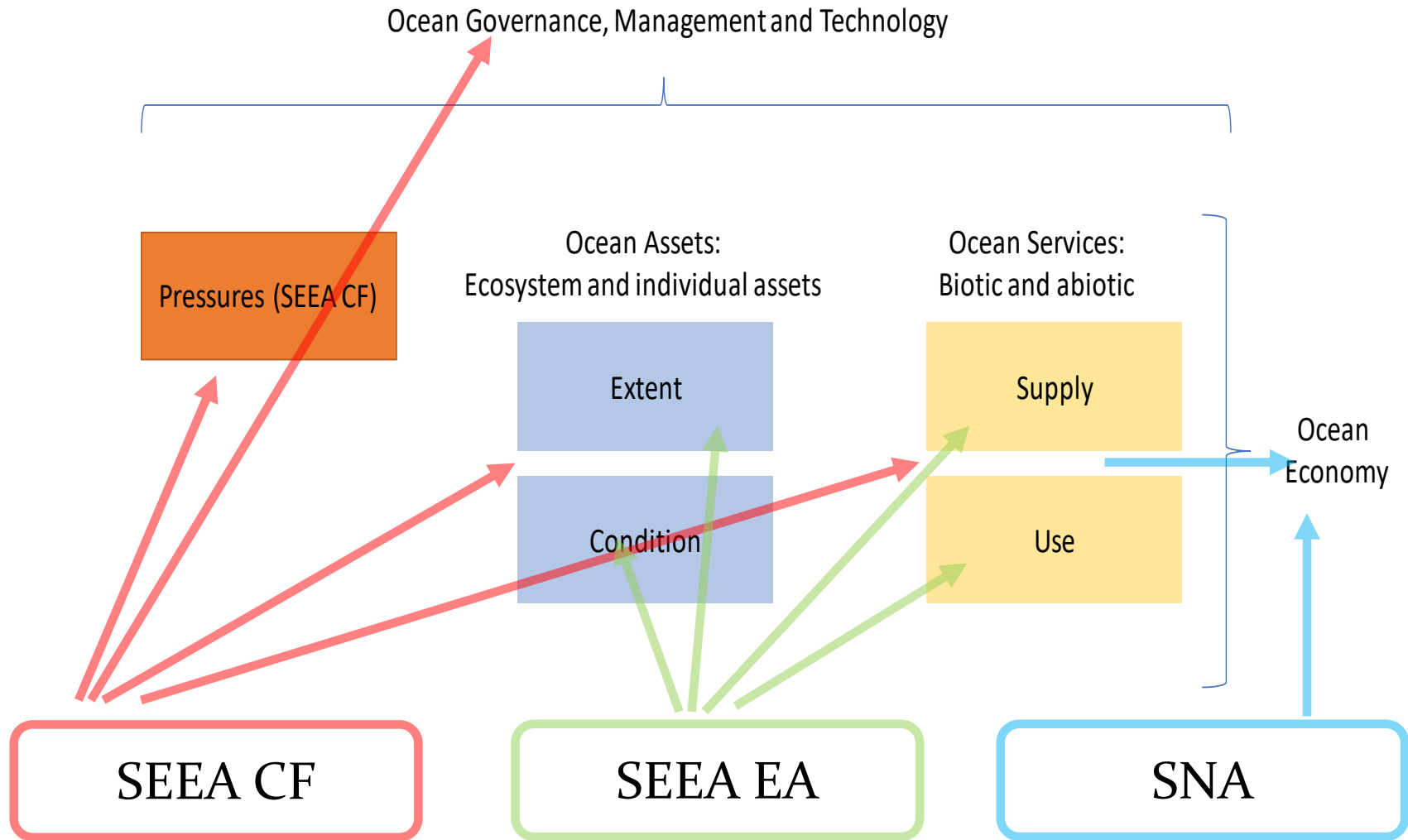


# Main points (ocean accounts)

- The five pages in Chapter 13 is the summary of a 215 page “Ocean Accounting Technical Guidance”
- This has been the culmination of 3 years of collaboration and piloting coordinated by ESCAP and the Global Ocean Accounts Partnership (GOAP)
- It was developed to serve needs expressed by countries to strengthen statistical capacity to produce ocean data and statistics to support sustainable use of the ocean (SDG14)
- Ocean data, statistics and governance are fragmented. An integrated framework will support integrated decisions.
- We borrowed from the SEEA CF, SEEA EA, SNA with governance concepts to provide a comprehensive and integrated framework to support pilot studies.
