VII. Local Information

A: Arrival at the Airport

Participants should make their own transportation arrangements from Beijing Capital International Airport to Tiantan Hotel. Taxis, airport shuttles and airport express (subway) are available at the Airport. Payment should be made in Chinese currency, Renminbi (RMB), for which foreign currency may be exchanged through authorized counters at the airport. It is about 40 minutes' drive from the Airport to the Hotel.

Estimated cost of taxi fare from Beijing Capital International Airport to the hotel (Tiantan Hotel) is around RMB 100-120 Yuan (about 31 kilometers).

You can also take the airport express subway from the airport to Dongzhimen, then transfer to Line 2 and get off at Chongwenmen Station, change to Line 5 and get off at Tiantan East Gate Station, then walk about 10 minutes to the Hotel.
