



Country Report - Denmark

London Group Meeting 5-7 November 2003

Regular publishing of environmental accounts

- Energy supply and use
- Emissions to air
- Water extraction and use
- Environmental taxes and subsidies
- Asset accounts for oil and gas

Most flow-data are by households and 130 industries. The accounts are supplemented by input-output modelling results showing indirect flows. Time series available.

Publication strategy

- Yearly publication showing accounts at medium detail (8/26 industries) with some explanatory text.
- Yearly input-output publication: *Input-output tables and analysis – imports, employment and environment*. Detailed tables (130 industries) on energy use and emissions to air. For expert users. Will be published in English language from 2004.
- Environmental Statistics Yearbook: Selected environmental accounts are published with less detail (8 industries) in a separate chapter in the yearbook containing environmental statistics. Quite much explanatory text.
- Statbank Denmark – www.statbank.dk. The database is free of charge and environmental accounts data can be exported in several file formats and presented as diagrams or maps. Also English language version.

Recent pilot projects/reports

- DMI and TMR Indicators for Denmark 1981, 1990 and 1997 – An Assessment of the Material Requirements of the Danish Economy.
- Analysis of Changes in Air Emissions in Denmark 1980-2001 – Time series, bridge tables and decomposition analysis.
- Nordic taxes – (together with Sweden, Norway and Finland).
- Forest accounts – physical and monetary asset accounts, including non-SNA functions.
