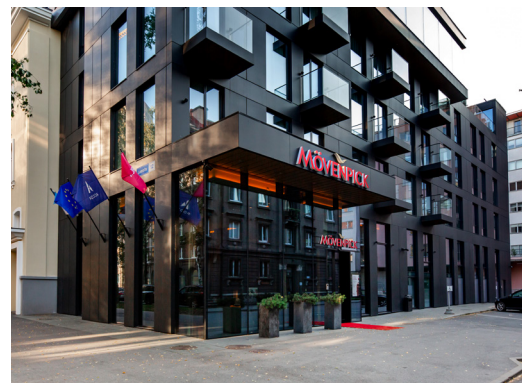

# GETTING AROUND

## PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

All London Group meeting participants will be able to use public transport in Tallinn for free. For this purpose, you will receive a QR code by e-mail before the conference. The free pass is valid from 19 to 29 September 2025.

### How to use QR tickets?

A QR ticket must be validated at the bottom of the rectangular orange validator located at the front door of the public transport vehicle: place the QR code displayed on your phone (or a printout) in front of the code reader screen situated at the lower part of the rectangular validator. The QR ticket must be validated each time when entering the public transport vehicle.



## TAXIS AND RIDESHARING

Taxis can be found lined-up at taxi stands (e.g. at the airport and in front of larger hotels) or can be ordered by phone or via mobile apps. Taxi rates are not fixed; the rates are posted on a yellow sticker on the car's right rear window. Taxis normally accept credit cards and provide receipts.

Ridesharing apps are also available and widely used in Estonia.

**Bolt:** verified private as well as professional taxi drivers

**Uber:** for private drivers only

## HOW TO GET FROM TALLINN AIRPORT TO THE CITY CENTRE

Lennart Meri Tallinn Airport is very conveniently located – just 4 kilometres (2.5 miles) from the city centre. You can easily travel to and from the airport by bus or taxi.

### By bus

You can get to the city centre from Tallinn Airport by buses:

**BUS 2** direction “Balti Jaam”, stop ESTONIA (for Mövenpick hotel)

**BUS 15** direction “Estonia”, stop ESTONIA (for Mövenpick hotel)

The buses leave from the airport's lowest level (stop Lennujaam), down the escalator from the arrivals hall – simply follow the signs.

### By taxi

The taxi stand is located outside, in front of the arrivals hall. The fare from the airport to the city centre is around €15.

## VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR ESTONIA

Estonia is a member of the European Union and part of the Schengen Area. Nationals of the European Union (EU), the European Economic Area (EEA) and any third-country national holding a residence permit of a Schengen state do not need a visa to enter Estonia. The only travel document required for these visa-free travellers is a national ID card or passport.

If you need a Schengen area visa, you can apply at an Estonian embassy in your country of origin. If there isn't an Estonian embassy or consulate in your country, you can apply at the office of an EU member state representing Estonia for issuing visas. For more information on visa exemptions and requirements for visiting Estonia, please consult the webpage of the Estonian Ministry of Foreign Affairs or contact your nearest Estonian representation.

## LANGUAGE

Estonia's official language is Estonian. English is widely spoken and understood. Estonia also has a large Russian-speaking minority. Finnish and German are understood and spoken somewhat.

Please note that the meeting will be conducted in English, and no interpretation services will be provided.



## CURRENCY

National currency: Euro (1 euro = 100 cents)

Most banks are open from 9:00 to 18:00 on weekdays, ATMs are located around the city. Credit cards are widely accepted in Estonia.



## TIME IN ESTONIA

Estonia is in the Eastern European Time Zone (EET): UTC/GMT +03:00.



## WEATHER

During late September, Tallinn typically experiences mild autumn weather. Daytime temperatures usually range from 12°C to 17°C (53°F to 63°F). Nights can be cooler, with temperatures dropping to around 5°C to 10°C (41°F to 50°F).

The weather is generally partly cloudy to mostly sunny, with occasional chances of rain. This makes it still a pleasant time for outdoor activities and sightseeing.



## TAP WATER IN TALLINN

Tap water is clean and safe to consume in Tallinn.



## POWER SUPPLY IN ESTONIA

The electrical current is 220 volts AC, 50 Hz, and electrical sockets take European-style two-pin plugs.



## SECURITY AND SAFETY

Estonia is a safe country with low crime rates. As in any country, you should look after your belongings and be aware of pickpocketing in busy urban areas.



## EMERGENCY NUMBER

Emergency number in Estonia is 112 for all emergencies. It can be dialled free of charge in case of need for ambulance, rescue, or police.



## SMOKING

Smoking is not allowed indoors nor public spaces, unless it is marked as designated area for smoking.
