

Change, Challenges

- Environmental Economic Accounting is "politically mainstreamed"
- UN CEEA as "high level" political steering committee for Environmental Economic Accounting
- LG has no own report = voice in the StatCom anymore report is part of UN CEEA's area B
- LG not like in the past tasked with the SEEA CF update
- Do we need the LG any longer or is it time to come to an end after 30 years?





Change, Challenges, Chances & Conclusions

- Without further development initiated by methodic expertise, environmental economic accounting is at an end.
- A strong methodological counterweight to the more politically orientated UN CEEA is necessary
- CEEA is currently updating its mandate and defining its relation to the LG new
- LG could consider doing the same
- Should we consider changing our name to London Group on Environmental **Economic** Accounting?
- Should we again report separately to gain more visibility?
- To be discussed not now but throughout the meeting and in the final session.
