
 The UNCEBTS was created in 2018 by the UN Statistical Commission to coordinate and guide the development of business and trade statistics

UNCEBTS Task Teams

- Five task team were created:
 - Globalization and digitalization
 - Well-being and sustainability
 - Business dynamics, Business demography and entrepreneurship
 - Exhaustive business registers
 - Capacity building (no one left behind) on statistical business registers
- They developed a 2-year work plan to improve and strengthen business and related trade statistics



Task Team on globalization and digitalization

Task team leader: Ms. Daniela Ravindra (Statistics Canada)

- Develop guidance for business statistics on globalization and digitalization related to the structure, activities and performance of businesses
- Identify information gaps based on a review of ongoing statistical initiatives in economic statistics
- Identify a set of core indicators on globalization and digitalisation
- Conduct joint global assessment on the status of implementation of business statistics on globalization and digitalisation



Task Team on Well-being and sustainability

Task team leader: Ms. Alison Pritchard (ONS-UK)

- Develop guidance for business indicators on wellbeing and sustainability, including social entrepreneurship, "decent work", environmental impact, and Sustainable Development Goals
- Focus on corporate sustainability, quality of jobs and environmental impact
- Conduct joint global assessment on the status of implementation of business statistics on well-being and sustainability



Task Team on Exhaustive Business Registers

- Task team leader: Mr. Hank Hermans (Statistics Netherlands)
- Develop guidance for the Statistical Business Registers to be inclusive and exhaustive in a rapidly changing economy and tailored to statistical production
- Provide guidance on business statistics obtained from statistical business registers
- Provide advice on development and maintenance of a Global Enterprise Group Register (GGR)



Task Team on Business dynamics, Demography and entrepreneurships


- Task team leader: Mr. Arturo Blancas (INEGI-Mexico)
- Review statistical guidance and country practices on business dynamics, business demography and entrepreneurship
- Develop supplementary guidance on core set of business statistics for business dynamics, business demography and entrepreneurship
- Conduct joint global assessment on the status of implementation of business statistics on business dynamics, business demography and entrepreneurship




- Task team leader: Mr. Saleh Alkafri (Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics)
- Develop a maturity model for Statistical Business Registers (SBRs)
- Conduct a global assessment on the status of implementation of SBRs in countries
- Prepare an inventory of available tools (IT tools, training material, e-learning, etc.) and make them more widely accessible through the UN website and dedicated e-learning platform
- Tailor tools to specific levels of maturity of SBRs in countries



• Develop a strategic vision for the future of business and trade statistics that is agile and responsive to the new emerging issues (e.g. enterprisecentric view, more granular data, linked business and trade statistics,...)



• Initiate collaboration with existing groups of experts in areas of common interest
