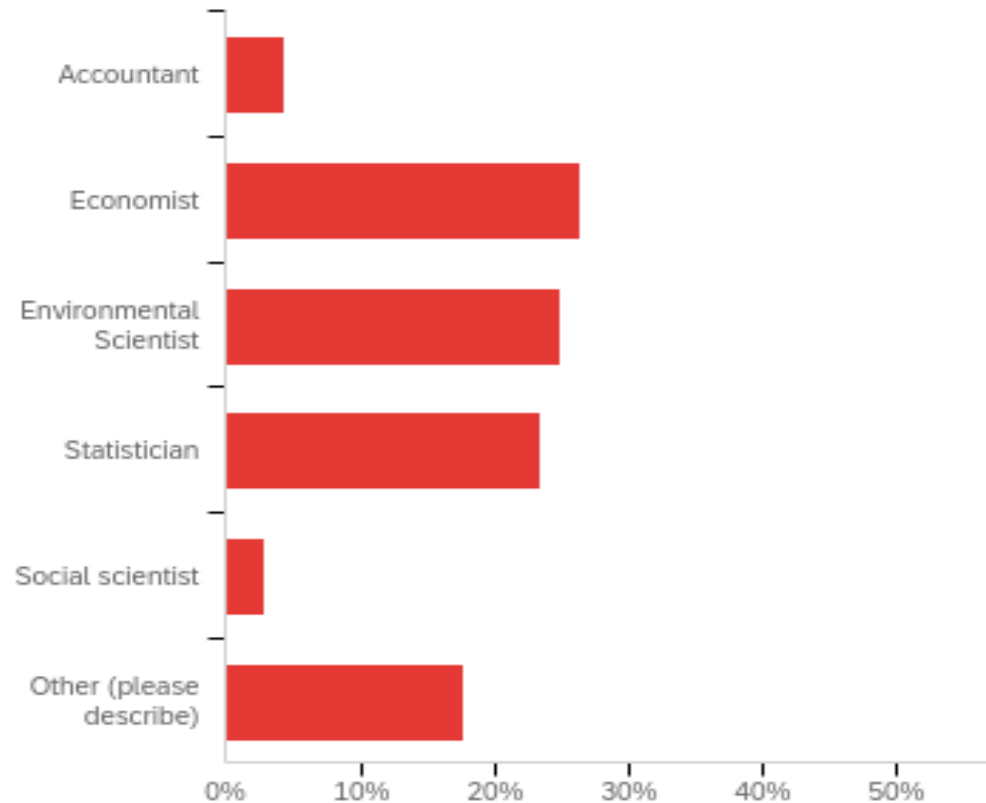

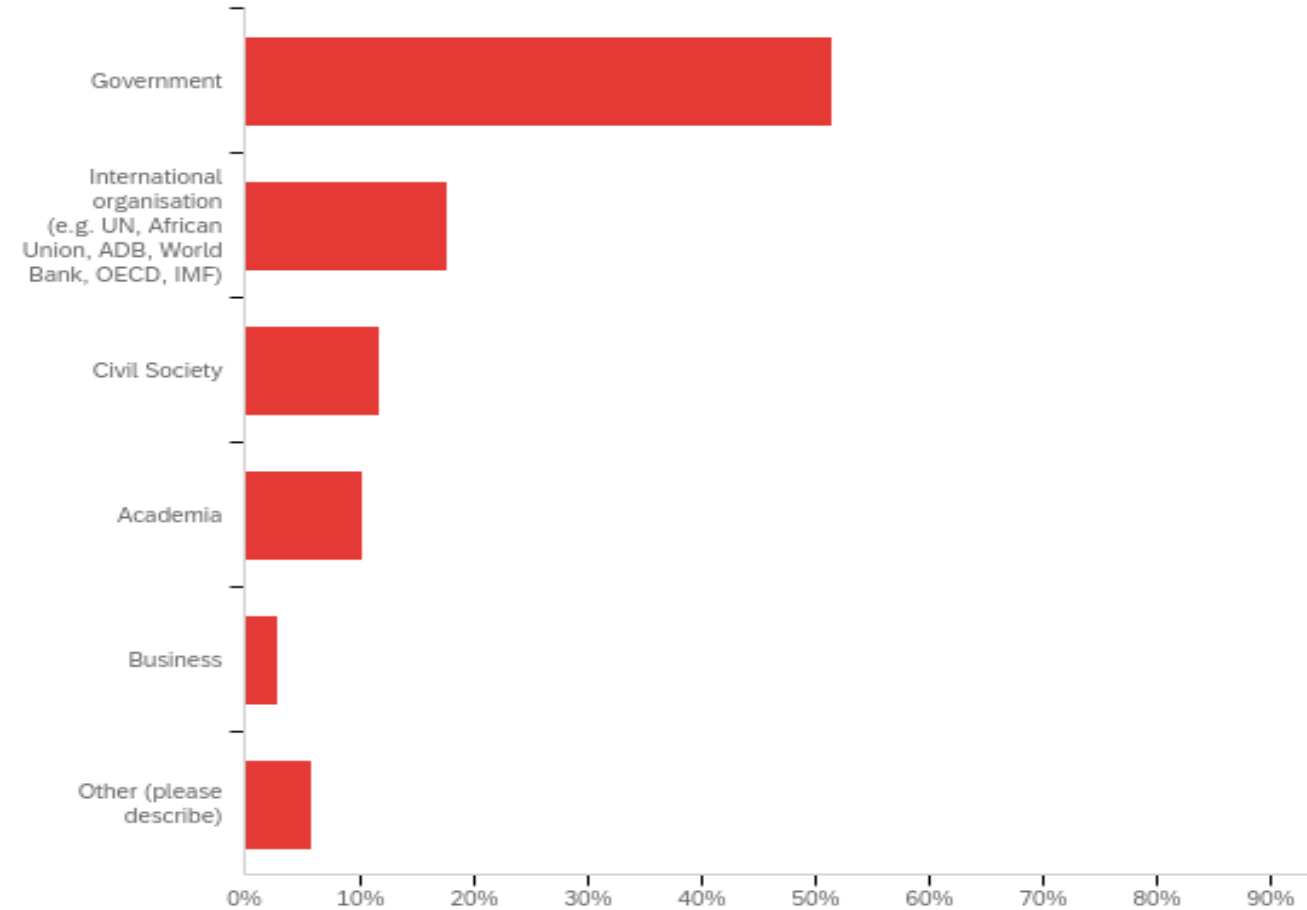

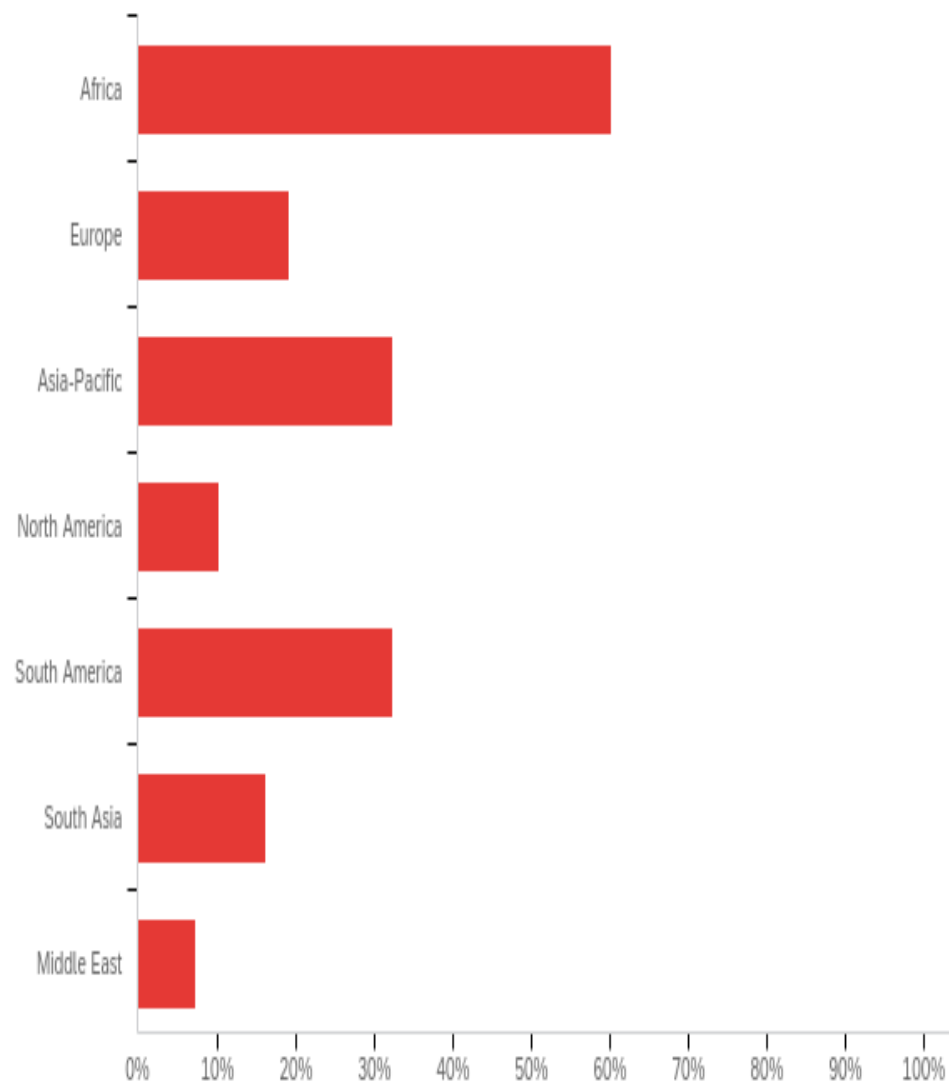

MIX OF ORGANISATIONS



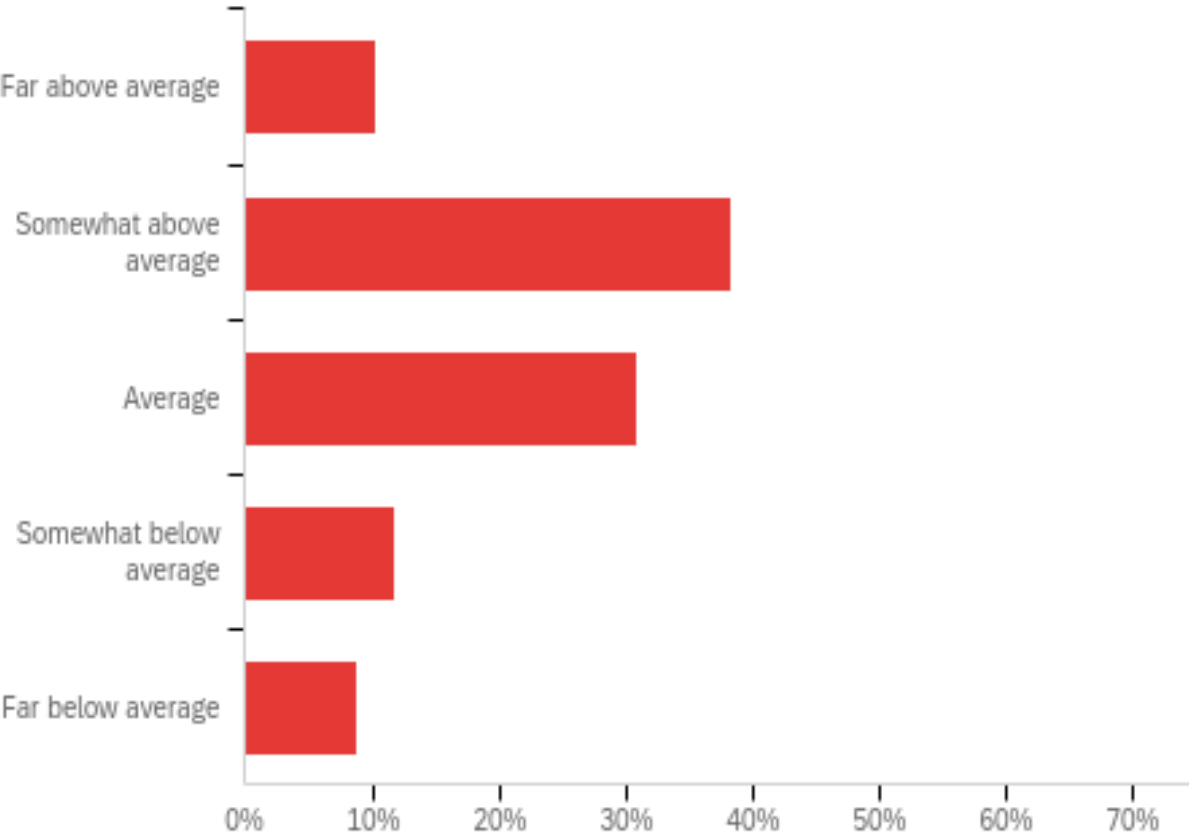

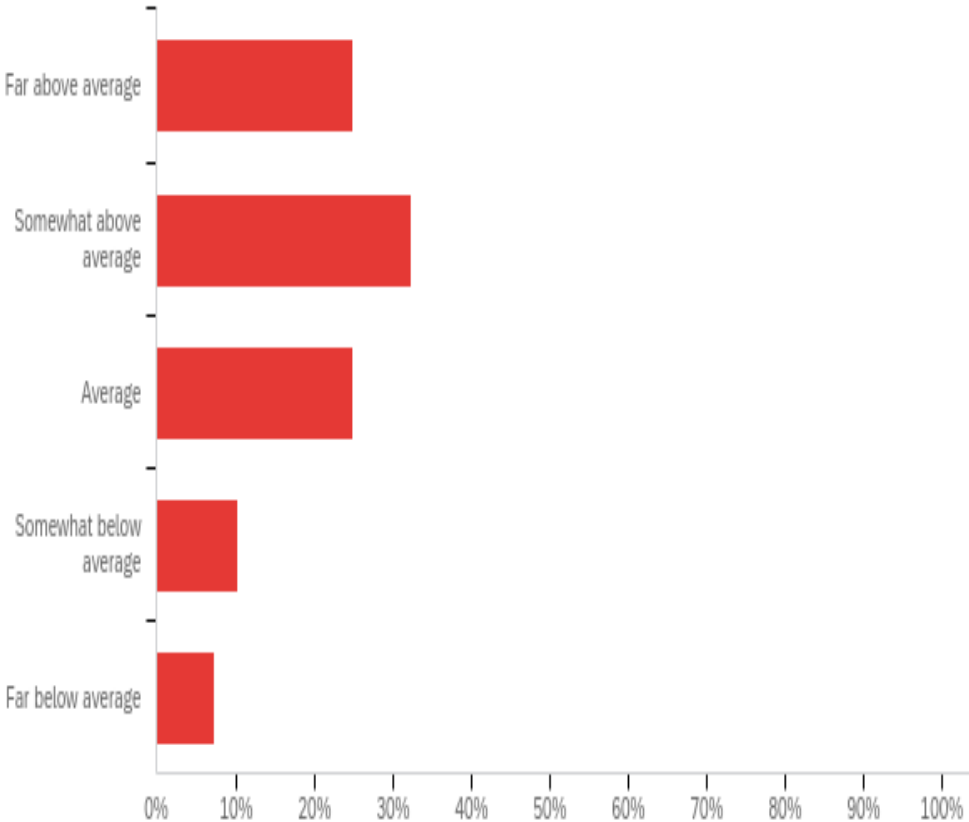

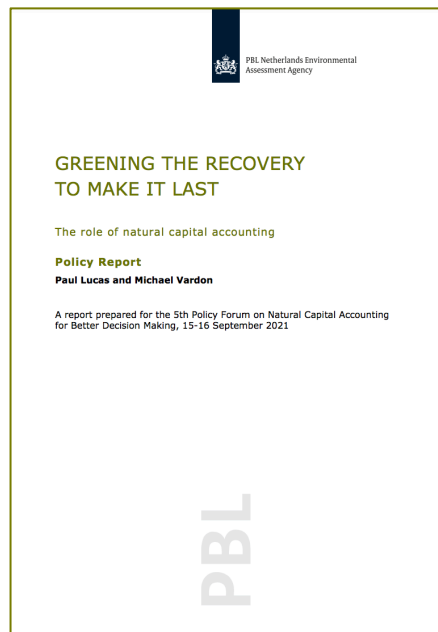


NATURAL CAPITAL ACCOUNTING



Key messages in report

1. Current recovery plans ignore the value of the natural capital
2. Investing in natural capital provides short-term and long-term social, benefits
3. NCA and modelling supports decision-making
4. NCA as an enabling environment



5. A green recovery is supported by existing data and expertise
6. NCA is most effective when mainstreamed
7. Existing agendas can reinforce each other, both supporting and supported by NCA
8. A green recovery means mainstreaming NCA

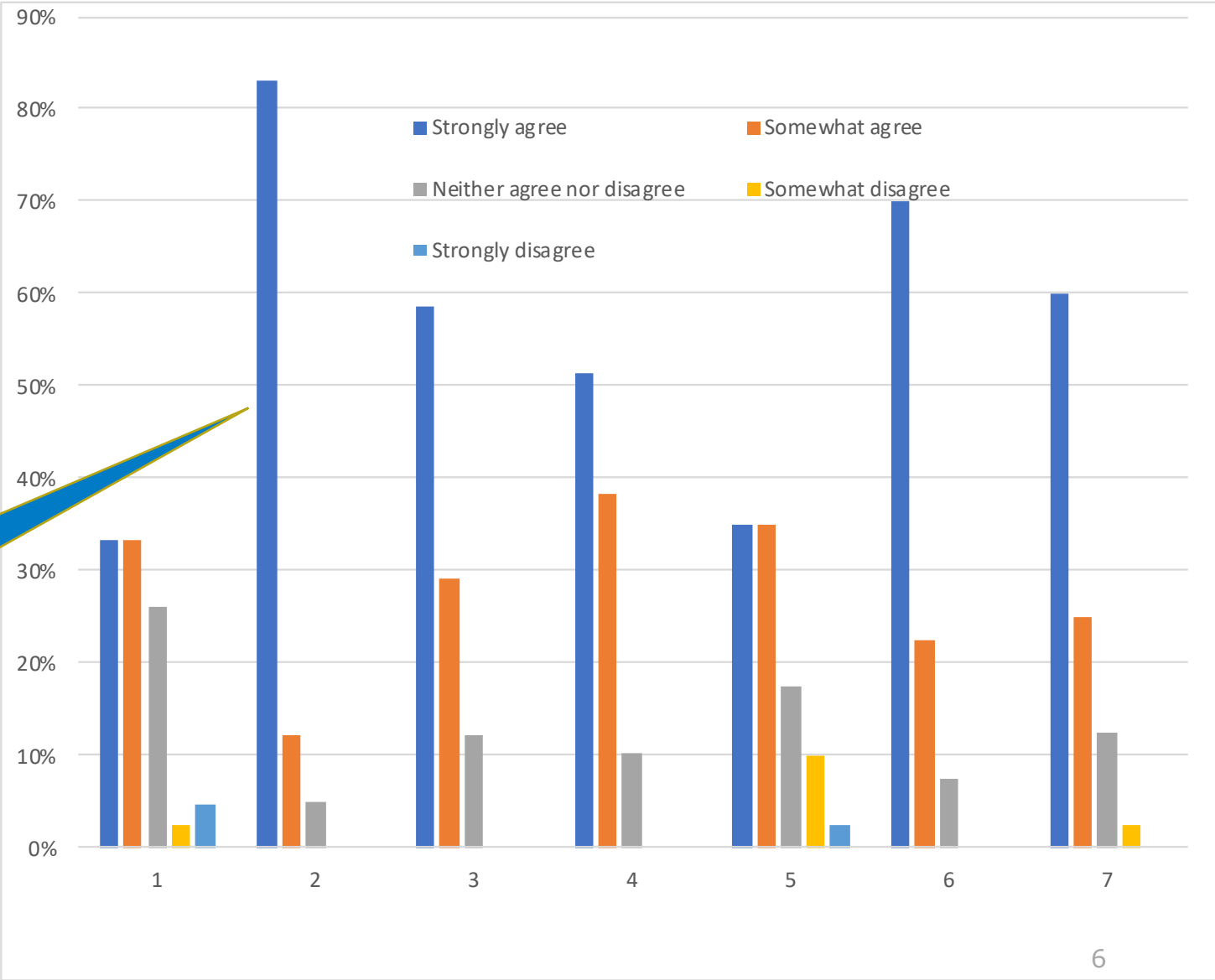
