


CHINA AS HOST COUNTRY

- Demonstration effect: the construction of ecological civilization in China could be a role model of sustainable development globally, similar role as China played in the frontier of climate change
- Experience sharing: bringing up experience and lesson learnt, foster new development idea and governance pattern
- Substantial contribution: sharing resource with other developing countries, including financial and technical resource
- Collective leadership: building the widest coalition possible, coordinating other leading countries, international organizations and social entities to make concerted effort, sending a clear signal to the world to arise political will

Since 1993 China has became a member of CBD. COP 15 of 2020 will be the 1st time for China to host the CBD COP
