## Progress on the SEEA CF research agenda

- 14 research topics are currently listed on the SEEA CF research agenda
- Three outcome papers have been prepared and are ready for approval by UNCEEA: 1) integrated framework for environmental activity accounts (Eurostat), 2) Economy wide material flow accounts (ISTAT), and 3) Global DSDs for data exchange for SDMX (Eurostat).
- Two topics added, two topics dropped
- This year work will commence on a) the revision of the classification for environmental activities (CEA)/ definition of resource management, and b) fossil fuel subsidies
- for 5 issues it is not clear when work will start because there is no topic lead



## PROPOSED PROCESS FOR FINALISING SEEA CF RESEARCH TOPICS

- Preparation issue paper by topic lead
- Review of SEEA CF TC
- Submission to UNCEEA for approval
- Global consultation (?) → Only for topics that propose a significant change with respect to the SEEA CF; UNCEEA decides
- After approval by the UNCEEA/ global consultation the outcome papers is published on the SEEA website



## PRIORITIZATION OF THE WORKPLAN

#### **Criteria for prioritization:**

- (International) implementation priorities
- Critical for SDG's
- Work already underway
- Critical for climate change statistics
- Agency is willing to lead the work (topic lead)

### PRIORITIZATION OF THE WORKPLAN

If we apply these criteria, the most important consequences for the work plan would be :

- Issues A4 (losses) and B6 (fishery issues) have low priority and should be removed from the research agenda.
- For issues A1 (residuals), A5 (linkages with SEEA EEA), B7 (resource material equivalents) either a lead topic needs to be identified or these issues also should be given a low priority and removed from the research agenda.



## **Revision of the SEEA CF**

Like all international standards, the SEEA should be revised on a regular basis

- → New user demands
- → Incorporate outcomes from the SEEA CF research agenda
- → Alignment with SEEA EEA
- → Alignment with SNA revision

#### **Key questions**:

- a) Should the SEEA CF be revised in 5-6 years' time or not, and if yes
- b) What steps should be undertaken to initiate this process?






## **Questions to the UNCEEA**
