Purpose


- Promote coordination with SEEA-relevant groups to evaluate the linkages between existing efforts.



Goals

- 1. Bring people together from various disciplines, including statisticians, policy makers, environmental economic accountants, national accountants, ecologists, etc.
- 2. Showcase the benefits of the SEEA, demonstrate how the SEEA can answer policy questions, and explore areas where the SEEA has not been used but could play a role.

Requirements

- Need to clearly identify audiences (e.g., policy departments, banking community) and how to engage theses audiences.
- Need to identify user needs and with that information develop series that reflect those needs as well as current topics and emerging issues.

Next steps

- Continue to play a role in its traditional space of fostering communication and coordination by meeting regularly and discussing key initiatives and emerging issues
- Identify key events and milestones relevant to the environmental accounting community which are happening in the next year and plan webinars around them
