Main outcomes related to the SEEA

- Endorsed the list of issues and the update process for the System of Environmental-Economic Accounting Central Framework
- Expressed its appreciation for the financial support by Eurostat and the IMF and inkind support by countries and international organizations, and encouraged continued support during the update process
- Approved the updated mandate and governance of the UNCEEA
- Welcomed and further encouraged the work on **mainstreaming the SEEA** into beyond-GDP, circular economy, biodiversity, sustainable tourism, climate change and disaster statistics initiatives, and the DGI Initiative



Main outcomes related to the SEEA

- Expressed its appreciation for the work of the UNCEEA related to the monitoring framework of GBF, and **encouraged the development of practical guidance** for the indicators related to the SEEA to support national efforts
- Noted the progress in developing global databases for the priority areas of the SEEA, and welcomed the plan to re-evaluate those areas for the next five years
- Welcomed the SEEA implementation in countries and the revitalization of the focal point network, and encouraged the UNCEEA to continue its efforts to coordinate capacity-building activities during the update process, also in support of the implementation of the 2025 SNA
- Welcomed the work of the London Group and encouraged the LG to continue to support the UNCEEA to update the SEEA CF
